You will gain a sound understanding of life as a photographer in England and build upon your portfolio, whilst lectures and field trips will build and expand your creative control and theoretical understanding.

The Summer Course will include visits to leading photographic studios in London and lectures from successful photographers in their field, who will deliver a series of exciting in-studio and location photographic assignments, using teams of assistants, stylists and models.

Through visits to some of London's leading photographic galleries, you will examine and compare leading British photographers. There will be opportunity for critical exchange through a visit to the 'Association of Photographers Student Awards' exhibition, highlighting some of Britain's leading new generation of photographers and providing a quintessential English viewpoint of photography practice.

You will explore the history, culture and development of English photography from the birth of the negative, and visit to Lacock Abbey and Museum, through to the expansion and culture of imaging in England.

Photographic exercises will explore location shooting with access to some of England's most beautiful and historic castles, mansions, quaint Dorset thatched villages and unique English coastline.

Highlights of the course include the chance for cultural exchange through a visit to a leading Photography Festival.

BA (Hons) Photography

YEAR 1

Introduces you to the technical skills and theoretical issues that are fundamental to photographic practice. You will be required to engage in a series of projects that address contemporary practice, challenge your creativity and provide grounding in studio lighting, printing and other photographic techniques.

YEAR 2

Will allow you to begin to define your own practice and specialism. Units of study become longer and more demanding, and experimentation and risk taking are encouraged. Digital imaging practice and theory are also major components of the curriculum.



Foundation Diploma Award – Commercial Photography

YEAR 1

Provides you with the creative and practical skills that you will build upon during the course. It introduces you to a variety of traditional and digital photographic techniques and processes through units in Principles and Practices, Digital Darkroom and Digital Production giving you a strong technical foundation in location, studio, lighting, camera and digital production techniques.

YEAR 2

Encourages you to reflect on your particular professional interests and to take responsibility for your learning through the unit Creativity in Context and culminating in the unit Professional Project. Projects for this unit are designed to develop your creative, research and conceptual skills combined with commercial and professional awareness and understanding.
